



Rooms with a view Nestled elegantly into the cliffs of Ardmore Bay in Waterford, the newly opened Cliff House Hotel makes the most of the stunning sea views, through the floor-to-ceiling windows and its expansive outdoor terrace. The intimate 39-bedroom hotel, designed by Coughlan DeKeyser Associates, dramatically spans seven floors, gradually edging down to the shore. The interiors, by Garry Cohn for Douglas Wallace, use natural materials with warm and inviting furnishings, and a colour palette of marine blue, fuchsia, aubergine and sea green, inspired by the sea and surrounding countryside. Interestingly, the hotel houses the largest private collection of antique British campaign furniture in Ireland. Under the expert management of Adriaan Bartels, formerly general manager of Sheen Falls Lodge, Co Kerry, this hotel promises a stylish stay.
