Crerar Hotels has unveiled the Craiglynne Hotel following a £750,000 refurbishment. The property's 82 new bedrooms blend Victorian charm with contemporary flair whilst the bar, lounge and conservatory have also undergone a new contemporary makeover. "When we purchased the Craiglynne Hotel last year, our vision was to bring it up to the standard of the Crerar brand and this refurbishment has certainly done that," says chief executive Paddy Crerar.



The Cliff House Hotel in Ardmore, Ireland, has undergone a modern makeover which capitalises on its seaside setting. Designed by interiors specialists Douglas Wallace, the interior of the hotel use of natural materials and warm and inviting furnishings in a carefully selected palette of deep marine blue, fuchsia, aubergine and sea green. "Designing a hotel is as complex a task as any designer can have because you have to imagine how the visitor will feel as they inhabit the space that you create for them," comments designer Gary Cohn.



The Harbour Hotel in Christchurch, Dorset has signed an agreement with renowned chef Gary Rhodes to bring two new restaurants to the town. Rhodes South – an 80-cover restaurant – will be based in the grounds of the Christchurch Harbour Hotel, housed in a custom-built and carbon-neutral contemporary building. Meanwhile King's Rhodes, in the former King's Arms Hotel, will offer a 100-cover bar and brasserie offering contemporary high street eating.



HKR Architects has revealed its plans for a four star deluxe Millennium Hotel at Southampton's Ocean Village. Guest accommodation will be a mixture of luxury suites, family guestrooms and club guestrooms. Facilities at the hotel will include banqueting and conferencing for up to 800; 139 car-parking spaces; destination restaurant and café bar – both with external terraces – together with a dedicated spa floor, as well as an executive and marina berth holders club lounge.
