

Douglas Wallace wins FX International Interior Design Award

(November 2006) - Douglas Wallace Architects and Designers' design for the g Hotel in Galway, in collaboration with Philip Treacy, has won the 'Best Hotel Design' award at this year's FX International Interior Design Awards. Douglas Wallace's work on the Habitat Flagship Store in Dublin was also recognised as a finalist in the Retail Design category.

Now in their eighth year, the FX Awards publicly recognise and reward the best in interior products and projects. Organised by leading contract interiors magazine FX, these coveted awards are the highlight in the industry calendar.

This 103-bedroom hotel is the flagship property of Monogram Hotels, Ireland's newest niche brand of luxury hotels. Douglas Wallace collaborated with design director, Philip Treacy, to create a five-star hotel interior unlike anything seen before in Ireland.

The FX Design Award is the latest addition to Douglas Wallace's awards successes in 2006. The company won 'Best Spa Design' at last week's European Hotel Design Awards.
